

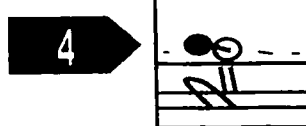
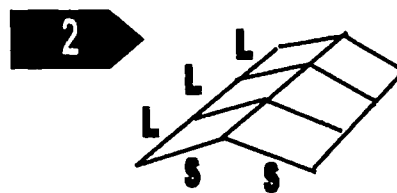
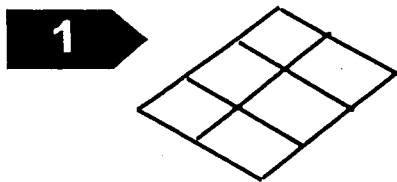


10 x 20 CANOPY KIT INSTRUCTION SHEET

- A. Place the roof pipes on the ground with the correct fittings next to the corresponding pipes as shown in diagram 1.
- B. Connect the pipes and fittings as illustrated in diagram 2. There are two different length pipes: 17- long pipes (for the length and legs) and 8- short pipes (for the peak).
- C. Drape tarp over roof frame and secure the corners onto the frame by using the ball tie downs as illustrated in diagrams 3 and 4.
- D. Once the corners are fastened, place the ball tie downs through all grommet holes and loop around pipe as illustrated in diagram 4.
- E. Lift one side of roof and slide the leg poles, then lift other side and insert the remaining leg poles as illustrated in diagram 5.

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR SAFETY

- A. In windy areas, the canopy can be anchored by using cement blocks, sand bags or plastic water filled jugs tied down with rope looped through the roof frame. We also recommend support bar braces for the corners and peak.
- B. In regions where heavy snow fall may occur, snow must not be allowed to accumulate on the roof as the weight may cause the structure to collapse.

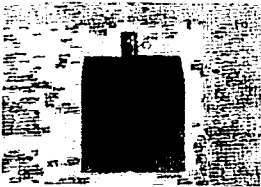


ADDITIONAL ACCESSORIES THAT MAY BE ORDERED

MESH SHADE TARP - A mesh shade tarp instead of the silver is ideal in windy regions. This tarp provides 73% shade and allows partial wind and rain to pass, thus making it perfect for nursery beds that need protection from heavy downpours.



CEMENT INSERTS - Make your own cement weights by inserting this fitting into a container and filling it with cement mix.



CEMENT WEIGHTS - Cement blocks will help secure your canopy to the ground in regions where high winds are common.



FOOT PADS - Foot pads will prevent your canopy legs from sliding or damaging the ground it sits upon.



TENT NAIL STAKES - These can be hammered through the holes on the base plate of foot pads to prevent shifting and hold the canopy down.



BALL TIE DOWNS - Available in short, medium and long lengths.



BAR BRACES - Available in 20", 40" and 54" lengths. Bar braces placed on every leg and peak provide strength and additional support for your canopy.
